Dear Students ,

Your final Semester Examination is commencing from 15th September onwards and you must be busy preparing for the same. I would like to clarify certain things explicitly to you so that you feel more comfortable for approaching examination.


- The date sheet has been devised in such a way that you get enough time for preparing the papers and also care has been taken so that only a minimum number of students come to the college during the examination.
- Regarding the relaxation in number of questions to be attempted it is clarified that marks **weightage for fifteen questions in 4 and 6 credit Courses** and marks **weightage for Eight questions in 2 credit courses** shall be awarded in advance to the students as they have to attempt only 45 Questions in 4 & 6 Credit Papers and 22 Questions in 2 credit papers.

An Illustration:

- (I) For a student who **(Maximum Attempt Scenario)**
- secures 45 marks in a 4-credit (Lab. Course), he/she will be awarded 60 marks i.e 100 percent marks.
 - secures 67.5 marks in a 6-credit (Non-Lab. Course), he/she will be awarded 90 marks i.e 100 percent marks.
 - secures 22 marks in a 2-credit course, he/she will be awarded 30 marks i.e 100 percent marks.
- (II) For a student who **(Minimum Attempt Scenario)**
- secures only 9 marks in a 4-credit course, he/she will be awarded 15 marks more so that the student passes with 24 marks.
 - secures only 13.5 marks in a 6-credit course, he/she will be awarded 22.5 marks more so that the student passes with 36 marks.
 - secures only 4.5 marks in a 2-credit course, he/she will be awarded 7.5 marks more so that the student passes with 12 marks.

Thirty five percent students are yet to submit the Examination forms and they are directed to do so well within last date of 8th September as link for submission will be closed from 9th September onwards. In no case examination forms will be accepted beyond 8th September as Examination Unit will require minimum one week to compile details and prepare necessary stationary for the Examination.

I am confident that this message will make you more comfortable and clear about your ensuing Examination.
