

Action taken report on Anti-Ragging Awareness Week, thereof

In continuation to the series of events in the campus, Anti-Ragging Awareness Week was celebrated from 12 August 2026 to 18 August 2026 with the objective of creating awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging and promoting a safe, respectful, inclusive and ragging-free campus environment. 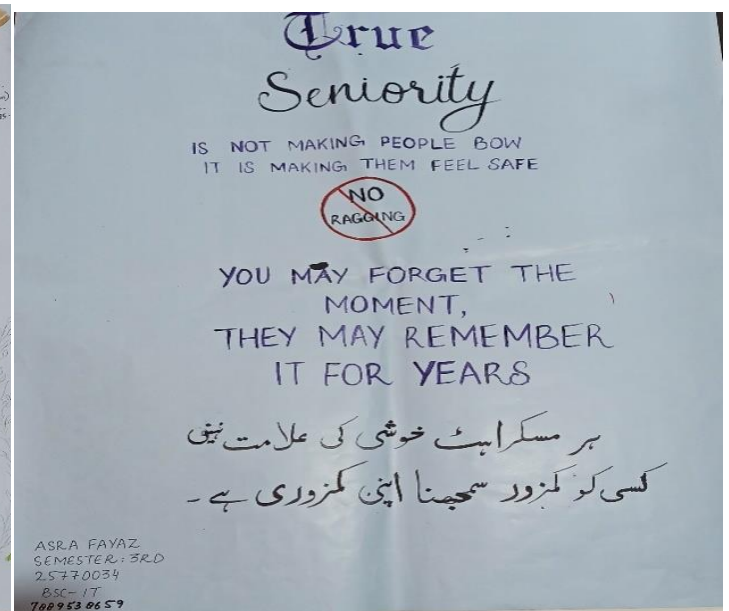
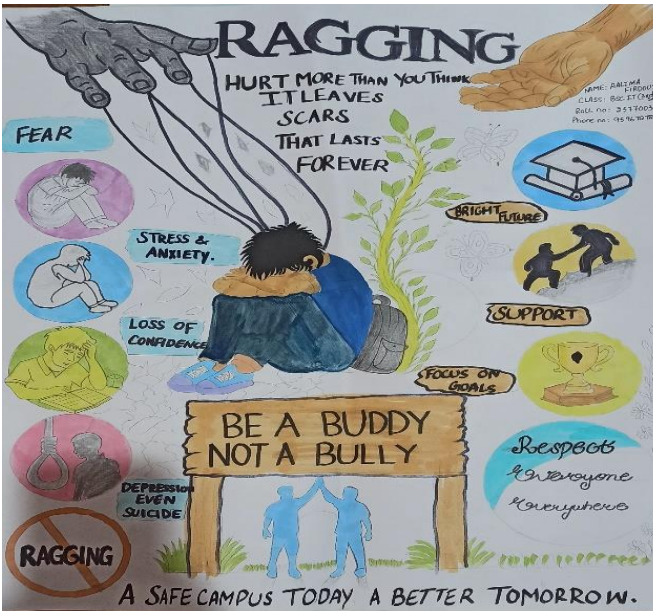
