The first three columns of the result sheet show subject code/subject Name/credits
Column 4,5 \& 6 respectively show the maximum marks allotted to the subject in terms of end semester (Max Th); Continuous Assessment (Max INT) and Practical/ Subject Tutorial (Max PR) (skill only)

Column $7,8 \& 9$ respectively show the mark obtained by the candidate in theory End Semester (OBT TH), in continuous Assessment (OBT INT) and in subject tutorials/Practical's (skill courses only OBT PR)

To qualify a subject, a student has to score at least $40 \%$ of the maximum marks allotted in each component of the subject. i.e.

18 out of 45 ; 14 out of $\mathbf{3 4}$; 9 out of 22 in theory papers (column 7)
6 out of 15; 4 out of 11 and 3 out of 8 (in T test's) (column 8) and
6 out of 15 in Practical (Skill courses only) (column 9)
Column 10 show the total marks scored by the candidate in a subject. The total is calculated only if the candidate is passing in all the components of the concerned subject i.e. is scoring at least $40 \%$ of the allotted marks as per the above description. If the student is failing in any of the components of a subject, the total will not be calculated(activated) and zero will be reflected in such columns.

SGPA will be calculated only for those students who qualify all the subjects in the semester otherwise the result will show (not qualified)

The progression of students upto semester 4th shall not be stopped even for the student who don't qualify the semester end examination of previous semesters.

Column $11,12 \& 13$ respectively show Grade, Grade point and Credit points respectively as per the scheme in vogue.
